

Honor Flight San Antonio de Valero

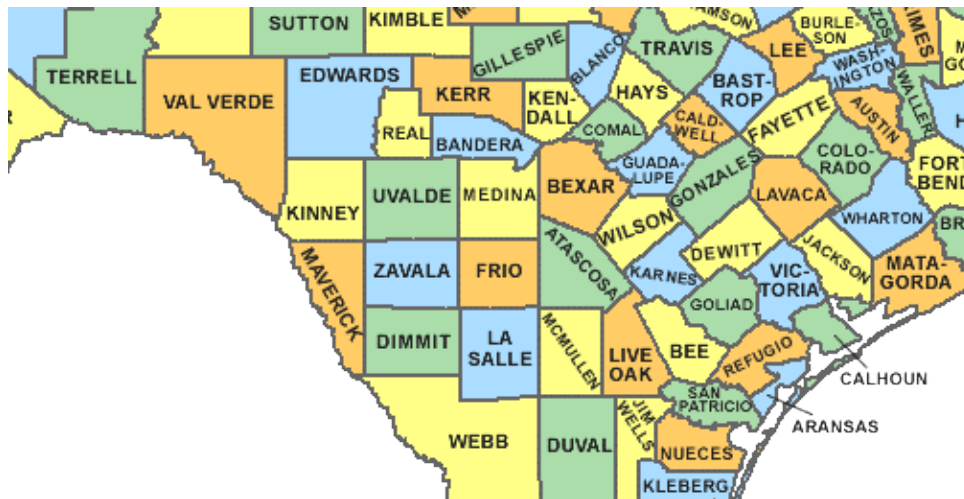

Priority is given to our area’s World War II veterans, and also any veteran with a terminal illness. To honor other veterans throughout the San Antonio area we are accepting and evaluating applications for Korean War and Vietnam War veterans that meet the National Honor Flight Network criteria.

The Counties We Serve

The *Honor Flight San Antonio de Valero* mission is to transport veterans, with a specific priority given to those residing within the counties listed below, to Washington, D.C. to visit those memorials dedicated to honor their service and sacrifices and return them home to their families and loved ones.

Honor Flight San Antonio de Valero serves the following counties: Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Comal, Guadalupe, Kendall, Kerr, Kinney, Wilson, as well as all the surrounding South Texas counties southeast to Matagorda, south to Duval, southwest to Webb, and west to Terrell counties.
